
It is indispensable to think: For every lesson, activity and action:



Reflective Practices to strengthen Teaching Learning Process:

Reflective Teaching is not a new idea. Dewey (1910, 1916) believed that teachers should take time to reflect on their observations, knowledge, and experience so that they can effectively nurture each child's learning. Reflective practice helps teacher to have a deeper understanding of their own Teaching styles, teaching beliefs and teaching identities. They should be constantly into the process of self observation and self evaluation. This reflective practice would be means of professional development which begins in the classroom. Some points of consideration in the reflection process might be what is currently being done, why it's being done and how well students are learning.

- 3. Evaluate your teaching using Research preferably Action Research
- 4. Question your Personal Theories and beliefs by critically analyzing self.
- 5. Consider alternative perspectives and possibilities by having learning conversation with your own self.
- 6. Try new strategies and innovative ideas.
- 7. Maximize the learning potential of students using inclusive practices
- 8. Enhance the quality of your Teaching by adopting effective practices and accepting the complexities of teaching and learning.. .
- 9. Be a professional Learner with right attitude, knowledge and competencies.
- 10. Give feedback to students that is clear, actionable, timely, consistent and goal oriented
- 11. Collaborate with other teachers to study and improve the practices.
- 12. Read Research on teaching and learning on a regular basis

Conclusion

Teaching and Learning is a complex process. Reflection demands Maturity and personal self indulgement.. It is not quick and easy. Reflective Teaching implies a more systematic process of collecting, recording and analyzing our thoughts and observations, as well as those of our students, and then going on to making changes.
